Agenda:

- Range time: 15 minute increments depending on your Range Time (Please check your Range Time the night before. You will only have 15 minutes on the Range due to limited space and a large field)
- Rules Meeting @ 8:15 - Please make sure you are near the large putting green at this time.
- Walk to holes @ 8:20 (Before leaving make sure you have your Prep Tour printed scorecard and know the location of your Starting Hole)

1. Moms are allowed to Caddy on Mother's Day! Please note that all other Spectators are still subject to standard Prep Tour Spectator Rules. Please keep your distance ( 30 feet) from Players and Caddies!
2. Pace of Play

Boys: 4 Hours $\mathbf{2 0}$ Minutes
Girls: 4 Hours $\mathbf{2 0}$ Minutes
3. Correct Tees: Varsity Boys: Blue Tees

Jr. Varsity Boys: White Tees
HS Girls: Red Tees
4. Drop zones on holes $\mathbf{5}, \mathbf{8}, \mathbf{1 1}, \mathbf{1 6}, \& \mathbf{1 7}$. On hole \#8, a player must enter the hazard through the yellow stakes to utilize the drop zone. Players who enter the hazard through the red stakes must seek standard red penalty relief. The drop zone is not a red penalty relief option on Hole \#8.
5. Range balls will be available for purchase in the clubhouse.

6. Prep Tour players are required to fix their ball marks and replace their divots. The Prep Tour appreciates the support of our host golf courses and insists that players do their part taking care of the championship venues our events are held at.
7. Players need to download the free Golf Genius app to their player cell phone. Parents and spectators do not need the app or a code to view the Tournament Leaderboard. Tournament links are posted on The Prep Tour Home Page www.preptour.com
8. Balls deemed OB must be replayed from the previous spot. Please use provisionals! USGA Alternative Local Rule E-5 is not an allowable option for Prep Tour Tournaments.
9. Sudden Death Playoff for 1st Place. USGA matching scorecard playoff for 2nd \& 3rd Place. Tiebreaker is Holes 10-18, then 13-18, then $15-18$, then $18-1$ backwards until the tie is broken.
